

# Wine List

## WINES BY THE GLASS

### WHITE

Sauvignon Blanc, Jolivet “Attitude”, Loire Valley.....11 44

A beautiful freshness in mouth, a frank attack, delicate green and lemon flavours, citrus fruits, green apple and kiwi aromas. The minerality gives a long finish to the wine, a smoothness and elegance.

Pinot Gris, Soléna, Willamette Valley .....10 42

Loaded with ripe peach and pear flavors. Lively and refreshing. There is a bit of fruit sweetness set against the natural acidity, keeping the wine poised and balanced.

Chardonnay, Goodfellow, Willamette Valley .....12 48

Medium-bodied, concentrated, refreshing acidity on the palate, with zesty white peach, lemon, cream, and pastry spice. Impeccably balanced, thirst-quenching, and finishes long and zippy.

### RED

Pinot Noir, Roco “Gravel Road”, Willamette Valley .....13 50

Rhubarb and strawberry fruit flavors roll into sweet red cherry, lightly spiced. The medium-long finish is textured and balanced, the tannins smooth and lightly toasty.

Syrah, Château Ste Cosme, Côtes-du-Rhône .....10 40

Violets, black olives and cassis and blueberry flavors provide terrific varietal expression in a medium to full-bodied package framed by silky tannins.

Malbec, Château La Grave, Cahors .....11 42

Dark, rich, and inky. Pretty aromas of dark berries and green herbs. Slightly metallic with lots of structure and tannin. Like Southern Rhone syrah with an extra dose of ripe blackberry.

Zinfandel, Badgerhound, California.....10 40

Appealing aromas of crushed raspberries and blackberries are framed by vanilla and cigar box notes.

Cabernet, Wines of Substance, Columbia Valley .....12 48

Wonderful, dark-fruit and olive character of a ripe cabernet sauvignon, but the polished tannins fold over the wine. It’s full-bodied, yet agile and focused at the finish.

# SPARKLING WINE

10. Brut, Gruet  
New Mexico NV ..... 40  
*A crisp, and full-bodied sparkling wine, which has developed rich complexity and fine mousse. The allure of the toasty finish is a complement to the sophisticated apple and citrus flavor. Winemaker's*
14. Brut, Chandon  
Napa NV ..... 52  
*Nutty flavors with hints of brioche that build to a refreshingly dry finish. The wine delivers complex apple and pear characteristics accented by citrus spice over notes of almond and caramel in the bouquet.*
15. Champagne, Veuve Clicquot "Yellow Label"  
Champagne, France NV ..... 110  
*A fruity while structured wine. It has both fresh and fragrant fruit as well as richness, a soft, creamy texture and bright acidity.*

# SAUVIGNON BLANC

21. Los Vascos  
Casablanca Valley, Chile 19 ..... 30  
*Honeydew, lime and lychee-scented nose that also reveals hints of wild asparagus and fresh lemon verbena. On the palate, this extroverted wine is lively, fresh, and gentle.*
- Jolivet, "Attitude"  
Loire Valley, France 18 ..... 44  
*A beautiful freshness in mouth, a frank attack, delicate green and lemon flavours, citrus fruits, green apple and kiwi aromas. The minerality gives a long finish to the wine, a smoothness and elegance.*
23. Honig  
Napa 19 ..... 40  
*Bright, and fresh. The flavors and aromas are reminiscent of peaches, lemon curd, white grapefruit, and passion fruit with perfectly balanced notes of citrus and stone fruit. The fullness of the midpalate is complemented by a crisp, lengthy finish.*
25. Roth  
Russian River, CA. 18 ..... 39  
*A rich expression of Russian River Valley fruit with notes of honeydew melon, tangerine, and citrus zest. Bright notes of floral honeysuckle, subtle barrel spice and flint balance the vibrant fruit-forward palate.*

# OTHER WHITES

30. Gruner Veltliner, Huber "Vision"  
Niederösterreich, Austria 19 ..... 37  
*The creamy freshness of green pear on the nose also has a hint of lemon peel. The body is light but zesty, easy but bright, fruit-driven but also rather peppery. It is a lovely, light offering.*
- Piont Gris, Solena  
Willamette Valley 18 ..... 42  
*Loaded with ripe peach and pear flavors. Lively and refreshing. There is a bit of fruit sweetness set against the natural acidity, keeping the wine poised and balanced.*

# OTHER WHITES CONT...

35. Vouvray Touraine, Champalou  
Loire, France 19.....51  
*The honey and white acacia blossom in this Vouvray's perfume is a rare treat. The wine has youthful deliciousness and great.*
39. Viognier, Pasanau "Les Myriams"  
Priorat, Spain 16 .....51  
*Bright and clean pale gold, fresh and aromatic, lots of white fruit, lots of minerality, good acidity, great structure, lots of volume, but without losing lightness and kindness. Memories of white candy, balm and butter.*
42. Rosé, Vaughn Duffy "Rosé of Carignane"  
Sonoma 19 .....38  
*A mélange of herbs and fruit are intertwined in this savory and snappy Rosé.*

## CHARDONNAY

- Goodfellow  
Willamette Valley, OR. 17.....48  
*Medium-bodied, concentrated, refreshing acidity on the palate, with zesty white peach, lemon, cream, and pastry spice. Impeccably balanced, thirst-quenching, and finishes long and zippy.*
50. Mount. Eden, "Edna Valley"  
Edna Valley, CA 17 .....48  
*Fabulously fresh, focussed and pure fruit make this a very pretty tippie. It is slightly sweet on the finish and generous, fruity and appealing with great grape and pear flavors.*
53. Chalk Hill, "Russian River"  
Sonoma, CA. 18.....48  
*Hints of baking spices and warm apple pie meld together to meet the nose. The fruit manifests rich textural body with extended notes of toasted hazelnut, vanilla custard and creme brulee that rein in the perfect balance of acidity and minerality.*
57. Rombauer  
Carneros, CA 18 .....84  
*Pale yellow with a green tinge to the hue. Aromas of yellow peach, mango with a slight citrus note intertwine seamlessly with vanilla and spice. The palate is rich and round, with the mango and vanilla fighting for the lime light, while the cream texture, vanilla and slight butter combine seamlessly.*
58. Fel  
Anderson Valley, CA 18.....72  
*Fresh, vibrant fruit aromas and flavors drive this full-bodied and well-balanced wine. It floods the palate with flavors of crisp apple, ripe pear and a touch of pineapple while subtle hints of baking spice play in the background.*
60. Lois Latour, "Montagny La Grand Roche"  
Burgundy, France 18 .....54  
*Crisp, bright, unoaked premier cru Montagny with more than a little similarity to a warmer-vintage Chablis. Peach and ripe melon fruit flavours, combined with a succulent texture and saline, stony finish.*

# PINOT NOIR

72. Willamette Valley, “Estate”  
Willamette, OR 18..... 69  
*Fresh red berry and rose oil scents pick up suggestions of cola and allspice as the wine opens up. Silky and seamless on the palate, offering bitter cherry and raspberry flavors enlivened by a gentle spicy element. The floral note comes back steadily on the gently tannic finish.*
- Roco, “Gravel Road”  
Willamette, OR 18..... 50  
*Rhubarb and strawberry fruit flavors roll into sweet red cherry, lightly spiced. The medium-long finish is textured and balanced, the tannins smooth and lightly toasty.*
74. Ken Wright, “Willamette”  
Willamette, OR 18..... 52  
*Ripe rainier cherry, red plum and blackberry are nestled between notes of rose petal, cedar and turned earth. The wine is vibrant and lively on the palate with a generous finish.*
75. J. Drouhin, “Cote de Nuits Villages”  
Burgundy, France 16 ..... 74  
*A delicious red Burgundy, with harmonious flavors. Bright ruby color. On the nose, intense aromas of wild cherry, licorice and mild spices, evolving towards notes of undergrowth and mushroom.*
77. Anthill Farms, “Sonoma Coast”  
Sonoma, CA 18..... 64  
*Pure scents of cranberries, blackberries, black tea leaves, fragrant earth and garrigue. In the mouth, it’s concentrated but light on its feet with a silky texture, floral fruits, seamless freshness and a long finish.*
78. Belle Glos, “Clark & Telephone”  
Central Coast 16 ..... 124  
*Lush aromas of blackberry bramble, nutmeg, and a hint of caramel. The wine is fresh and exuberant in the mouth with sumptuous strawberry jam, ripe black cherry, cranberry and warm gingerbread.*
79. Martin Wood, “Havlin Vineyard”  
Van Duzer, OR 17..... 75  
*Light and toasty, with a crisp feel to the roasted pear and white pepper flavors, finishing on an dusty earth and spice, bright cranberry and cherry, medium frame with vibrant freshness and length. Resolved and integrated tannin structure.*

# LIGHT BODIED REDS

90. Rubrato Aglianico, Feudi Di San Gregorio  
Campania, Italy 17 ..... 50  
*Chewy and savory, this smooth young red doles out ripe black-cherry, juicy blackberry, licorice and baking-spice flavors. It’s generous and ready to enjoy, with polished tannins.*
95. Melbec, Ben Marco  
Mendoza, Argentina 17 ..... 46  
*The freshness and saltiness to this is fantastic. Medium-to full-bodied, firm and super silky with an extremely long and driven finish. Vertical and focused.*
- Melbec, Chateau La Grave “Cahors”  
Cahors, France 18 ..... 42  
*Dark, rich, and inky. Pretty aromas of dark berries and green herbs. Slightly metallic with lots of structure and tannin. Like Southern Rhone syrah with an extra dose of ripe blackberry.*
97. Melbec, Valglio “Temple”  
Mendoza, Argentina 17 ..... 42  
*Notes of dark black fruit, rose petals, and hints of baking spices and coriander. Fresh baked bread and lemon custard coat the palate with a cocoa powder that leads to a smooth, long finish.*

# BOLD REDS

103. Garnacha, Pasanau “Ceps Nous”  
Priorat, Spain 17 ..... 52  
*Concentrated and voluptuous ripe fruit is complemented by strong minerality and wood spice on the nose and finish.*
105. Tempranillo, Condado de Haza  
Ribera del Duero, Spain 16 ..... 53  
*Lots of body, well integrated acidity, well-rounded tannins providing volume and persistence on the palate. The licorice aromas are present on the aftertaste.*
- Zinfandel, Badgerhound  
Sonoma, CA 17 ..... 40  
*Appealing aromas of crushed raspberries and blackberries are framed by vanilla and cigar box notes.*
110. Zinfandel, Plungerhead “Old Vines”  
California 18 ..... 42  
*Aromas of brambly raspberry, fresh-from-the-oven cherry pie, cinnamon-infused tea, toasted cedar, and clove. The flavors start with touches of Bing cherry, sweetened cranberry, raspberry jam, caramel and toasted coconut.*
113. Zinfandel, Green & Red “Chiles Canyon”  
Napa, CA 17 ..... 60  
*Focused and zesty, with brooding blackberry, grilled dill and white pepper flavors that take on broad-shouldered tannins on the finish.*
115. Zinfandel, Turley “Old Vines”  
Napa, CA 18 ..... 60  
*Silky, structured, savory, and seriously satisfying, this wine has kind of natural depth, complexity, and grace that can only come from truly old vines.*
- “Cotes du Rhone”, Chateau De Saint Cosme  
Rhône, France 19 ..... 40  
*Violets, black olives and cassis and blueberry flavors provide terrific varietal expression in a medium to full-bodied package framed by silky tannins.*
125. Syrah, Owen Roe, “Ex Umbris”  
Columbia Valley, WA 18 ..... 52  
*Finds a groove between ripeness, oak, flavor and finesse, folding together with a mix of fig, pear, nectarine and tangerine notes.*
127. Syrah, Slight of Hand “Levitation”  
Columbia Valley, WA 17 ..... 93  
*Aromas of dark roasted coffee, fresh herbs, plum, violet, smoke and soot, leading to plentiful, full-bodied fruit and savory flavors.*
129. Gigondas, Redortier  
Rhône, France 15 ..... 77  
*Bright ruby. Intensely perfumed aromas of red and dark berries, sandalwood and lavender show excellent focus. Stains the palate with appealingly sweet raspberry and cherry flavors.*
131. Merlot, Januik  
Columbia Valley, WA 16 ..... 52  
*Notes of dried herb, dark chocolate, cherry and cedar. Well-proportioned, slightly jammy red- and black-fruit flavors follow, supported by a lovely sense of structure and accented by plentiful barrel spices.*
135. Merlot, La Jolta “Howell Mountain”  
Napa, CA 16 ..... 185  
*Round and bright, with white peach, grapefruit and stone notes backed by a steely structure.*
202. GD Vajra, “Albe Barolo”  
Nebbiolo Piedmont, Italy 16 ..... 90  
*Rose petals, rose hips, cherry stones on the nose, followed by delicate tones of Nebbiolo pomace, tar, cranberries and raspberries, mint, anise, gentle musk and a whiffle of white pepper. In the palate, it’s fragrant and uplifting, yet disclosing a rich texture, a fresh but poised mid palate and velvety tannins.*

# CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 150.Reininger, “Helix”  
Walla Walla, WA 16..... 48  
*Black currant, baked plum and cherry greet the nose with fragrant rose petal attar, baking spice and hints of herb. Fine tannins carry the plum and black currant to a mid-palate of cherry and fig.*
- 152.Justin  
Paso Robles, CA 18..... 75  
*Clear notes of earth, vanilla and slightly toasted oak, complemented by strawberry, raspberry and blackcurrant aromas. The wine has a soft entry, with balanced acidity and tannins.*
- 153.B R Cohn, “Silver Label”  
Sonoma, CA 18..... 50  
*A bold, rich Cabernet with aromas of cassis, black cherry, mint and violet combine with a bouquet of pungent oak, anise and warm vanilla. On the palate, lush cherry, caramel, and clove are wrapped in smooth tannins and a long juicy finish.*
- 154.Mount Veeder  
Napa,CA 18 ..... 94  
*Impeccable. It is the minerality that dominates, but there is no denying the wine’s pedigree and sheer class. With air, the aromas and flavors become vivid, nuanced and breathtakingly beautiful.*
- 155.Keenan  
Napa,CA 15 ..... 120  
*Displaying a deep garnet-purple color and nose of expressive blackberries, blueberries and pencil shavings plus lovely dried leaves, rose hip tea and fragrant earth nuances, this Cabernet Sauvignon is medium to full-bodied in the firm, taut, energetic and lively mouth, with grainy tannins and a long, earthy finish.*
- Wines of Substance  
Columbia Valley,WA 18..... 48  
*Wonderful, dark-fruit and olive character of a ripe cabernet sauvignon, but the polished tannins fold over the wine. It’s full-bodied, yet agile and focused at the finish.*

## BLENDS

- 176.Chappellet, “Mountain Cuvee”  
Napa,CA 18 ..... 86  
*Vivid fruit and rich, soft tannins this red blend beautifully expresses the distinctive qualities of the traditional Bordeaux varietals. The aromas and flavors entice with dark berries, ripe plum, vanilla and spicy oak.*
- 179.Aia Vecchia, “Sor Ugo”  
Tuscany, Italy 17..... 86  
*Impressive notes of redcurrants, cassis, leafy herbs, and cedar all emerge from the glass, and it’s medium to full-bodied, has a solid spice of acidity, outstanding balance.*
- 180.Chateau Graysac  
Medoc, Bordeaux 15..... 69  
*Has a perfumed bouquet with plenty of tobacco-infused black fruit, just a touch of warm gravel emerging with time. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, crisp in the mouth with a very precise finish that deserves a round of applause.*
- 181.Marquis de Bellefont, “Grand Cru”  
Saint-Emilion,Bordeaux 15..... 84  
*Beautiful and intense purple colour with hints of ruby. Blueberry and cherry character with hint of smoke follow through to a full body, with big velvety tannins. Lovely juicy fruit with dried-berry, mushroom and plum character. Flavorful finish.*
