GRUET \$40

NV BRUT, NEW MEXICO

- 40 A crisp, and full-bodied sparkling wine, which has developed rich complexity and fine mousse. The allure of the toasty finish is a complement to the sophisticated apple and citrus flavor. Winemaker's Note: Brilliant with ultra fine bubbles.

LUNETTA \$32

NV PROSECCO, ITALY

- 41 Enticing aromas of apple and peach give way to a palate that is refreshing, and harmonious, with crisp fruit flavors and a clean finish.

DOMAINE CHANDON \$52

NV BRUT, NAPA, CALIFORNIA

- 43 Nutty flavors with hints of brioche that build to a refreshingly dry finish. The wine delivers complex apple and pear characteristics accented by citrus spice over notes of almond and caramel in the bouquet.

ROEDERER \$73

NV ANDERSON VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

- 44 An enticing, toasty, nutty aroma leads to crisp and complex flavors in this medium-bodied wine that is braced by good acidity and a fine bead of bubbles.

PATRICK BOTTEX \$56

NV LA CUEILLE, BUGEY-CERDON, FRANCE

- 45 This wine is delightfully refreshing with bright fruit, a beautiful rose hue, and a touch of sweetness. Hand harvested, natural fermentation.

VEUVE CLICQUOT \$148

NV BRUT, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

- 46 Perfect example of harmony between delicacy and power. Dominated by Pinot Noir, this wine has a firm structure, rounded with a touch of Pinot Meunier. Nearly a third of Chardonnay gives it the elegance and finesse needed for perfect balance.

DOMAINE CHANDON \$60

NV, ROSE, NAPA, CALIFORNIA

- 47 On the palate, the wine is creamy and seductive, with defined structure from the addition of still Pinot Noir at tirage. The overall impression is one of bold vibrancy and impact from start to finish.

PERRIER-JOUET \$130

NV GRAND BRUT, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

- 48 Meyer lemon peel, poached apricot and pastry cream notes are tightly meshed with a minerally underpinning and racy acidity in this vivacious Champagne. Creamy finish.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

LOS VASCOS \$30

61 2020, CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE

Honeydew, lime and lychee-scented nose that also reveals hints of wild asparagus and fresh lemon verbena. On the palate, this extroverted wine is lively, fresh, and gentle.

JOLIVET \$38

62 2019, "ATTITUDE," LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE

A beautiful freshness in mouth, a frank attack, delicate green and lemon flavours, citrus fruits, green apple and kiwi aromas. The minerality gives a long finish to the wine, a smoothness and elegance.

HONIG \$40

2020, NAPA, CALIFORNIA

63 Bright, and fresh. The flavors and aromas are reminiscent of peaches, lemon curd, white grapefruit, and passion fruit with perfectly balanced notes of citrus and stone fruit. The fullness of the midpalate is complemented by a crisp, lengthy finish.

ROTH \$39

2018, RUSSIAN RIVER, CALIFORNIA

65 A rich expression of Russian River Valley fruit with notes of honeydew melon, tangerine, and citrus zest. Bright notes of floral honeysuckle, subtle barrel spice and flint balance the vibrant fruit-forward palate.

GROTH \$53

2019, NAPA, CALIFORNIA

66 A creamy, viscous entry adjoined in jasmine. Lemon pitch, grapefruit and tangerine present as lush and lengthy on the palate, balanced by fresh, persistent acidity.

DRY CREEK \$42

2020, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA

67 Elegant and precise, with juicy peach, melon and blood orange flavors on a supple frame. Orange blossom and lemon sherbet notes linger on the fresh finish.

KOYLE COSTA \$38

2020 LA FLOR, COLCHAGUA VALLEY, RAPEL VALLEY, CHILE

71 Presenting a pale, steely yellow profile in the glass, while aromas include lime, rue, grapefruit and gunpowder. Featuring good fat in the mouth and heightened freshness, it ends with a lime-infused finish.

LES HAUTS DE LAGARDE \$38

2018 BLANC, AOP BORDEAUX, FRANCE

75 This is a delicious, ripe wine that is packed with apricot, apple and pear fruits. It is tangy and freshly fruity. The bright, rich fruit continues right through this wine that is ready to drink now.

OTHER WHITES

HUBER \$37

- 90 2019, "VISION" GRUNER VELTLINER, NIEDERÖSTERREICH, AUSTRIA
The creamy freshness of green pear on the nose also has a hint of lemon peel. The body is light but zesty, easy but bright, fruit-driven but also rather peppery. It is lovely, light offering.

ANNE PICHON \$47

- 91 2019, "SAUVAGE," VIOGNIER, RHONE, FRANCE
Clean and racy, with brite with notes of green apple, grapefruit and stone. Pointed, with a metallic finish.

TASCA D'ALMERITA \$45

- 92 2017 CATARRATTO ANTISA, D.O.C SICILIA, ITALY
A brilliant lemon-green, Antisa Catarratto explodes with ripe citrus and and stone fruit blossom. On the palate, the wine is crisp and firm with a pleasant broadness from the lees contact. A clean and balanced finish.

DURIN RIVIERA \$36

- 93 2019, PIGATO, LIGURIA, ITALY
Ripe and inviting on the palate, notes of white peaches and juicy lemons return alongside compelling touches of wildflower honey, white pepper, sunflower seeds, and fresh herbs. Salty minerals dust the lips and inner cheeks as the wine lingers on its long, brisk, and joyful finish.

BIANCHI \$32

- 94 2019, PINOT GRIGIO, CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA
Focusing on blossomy fruit and varietal character. Aromas of honeysuckle, melon and kiwi are enhanced by minty overtones. Full-bodied, the finish is crisp, clean and satisfying.

CHAMPALOU \$51

- 95 2019, VOUVRAY, TOURAINE, LOIRE, FRANCE
On the palate, it's luscious but not cloying, with ripe tropical and stone fruit tastes combined with citrus and floral notes. It lingers in the mouth with refreshing acidity and minerals.

PINE RIDGE \$40

- 96 2020, CHININ BLANC-VIOGNIER, CLARKSBURG, CALIFORNIA
Boasting a bouquet of honeysuckle, orange blossoms, rub grapefruit, white peach, and jasmine tea. The entry is both bright and mouth filling, exhibiting refreshing acidity and roundness, opening to flavors of tangerine, lime, and lemon curd, lemongrass, ginger, white peach, and green apple.

LA CLOSERIE DES LYS \$32

- 97 2019, LES FRUITIERES ROSE, LIMOUX, LANGUEDOC, SUD DE FRANCE, FRANCE
This pale rosé blends syrah, cinsault, grenache, and merlot from Limoux. Fruit for the rosé comes from the highest elevation plots, hence the inherent freshness here. Wild strawberries, grapefruit, orange, and watermelon ride a slender, juicy frame, finishing snappy and bright. Lovely food-friendly or solo sipping pink.

DOMAINE DE COURON \$32

- 98 2020, ROSE, ARDECHE, RHONE, FRANCE
Soft and stylish with an endlessly refreshing palate of summer cherry, watermelon and passion fruit flavors. Clean with good fruit-filled body and a dry finish.

SARACCO \$36

- 99 2020, MOSCATO D'ASTI, PIEDMONT, SPAIN
Straw yellow with greenish hues, fine perlage, intense orange blossom, peach and thyme. Tast: intense, elegant and lingering. The sweet sensations are well balanced with a pleasant acidity and fruity aromas.

DOMAINE DU VIEUX TELEGRAPHE \$160

- 100 2019 LA CRAU, CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, FRANCE
Lemon, stone fruit, apricot and white peach on the nose. Pale gold with a nutty palate. Slightly oily, medium acidity, medium body, well integrated and well balanced.

CHATEAU D'EPIRE \$75

- 106 2018 MOELLEUX GRAND CRU, SAVENNIERES, FRANCE
Wonderfully honeyed, sweet Savennières wine has an alluring bouquet of stewed pears, beeswax and fleurs blanches and a ripe, rounded, terrifically textured. Palate of grilled nuts and orchard fruit with an underlying acidity and subtle mineral nuances.

CHARDONNAY

MOUNT EDEN \$48

- 110 2017, "EDNA VALLEY," EDNA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA
Scents of toasted pine nuts and almonds, tangerine rind and lemon balm. There is racy acidity on the sip, where lemon peel, crisp pear and buttered apple flavors make for a very thorough Chardonnay.

AU BON CLIMAT \$48

- 111 2019, SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA
This barrel fermented, full-bodied Chardonnay has mouth-filling citrus fruit and a palate cleansing, bright finish.

MORGAN \$58

- 112 2018 HIGHLAND, SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS, MONTEREY, CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA
Aromas of pear, clove, green apple, and caramel. On the palate, aromas are complemented by a light touch of meyer lemon, graham cracker, and nutmeg. Incredibly food-friendly, this Highland Chardonnay is a perfect match for cream-sauced pastas, roast pork, and seafood.

CHALK HILL \$48

- 113 2019, "RUSSIAN RIVER," SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
Hints of baking spices and warm apple pie meld together to meet the nose. The fruit manifests rich textural body with extended notes of toasted hazelnut, vanilla custard and creme brulee that rein in the perfect balance of acidity and minerality.

ROMBAUER \$84

- 117 2019, CARNEROS, CALIFORNIA
Pale yellow with a green tinge to the hue. Aromas of yellow peach, mango with a slight citrus note intertwine seamlessly with vanilla and spice. The palate is rich and round, with the mango and vanilla fighting for the limelight, while the cream texture, vanilla and slight butter combine seamlessly.

FEL \$72

- 118 2018, ANDERSON VALLEY, CALIFORNIA
Fresh, vibrant fruit aromas and flavors drive this full-bodied and well-balanced wine. It floods the palate with flavors of crisp apple, ripe pear and a touch of pineapple while subtle hints of baking spice play in the background.

LOUIS LATOUR \$54

- 126 2018, "MANTAGNY LA GRAND ROCHE," BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Crisp, bright, unoaked premier cru Montagny with more than a little similarity to a warmer-vintage Chablis. Peach and ripe melon fruit flavours, combined with a succulent texture and saline, stony finish.

DOMAINE CHEVEAU \$60

- 128 2018, MACON SOLUTRE-POUILLY "SUR LE MONT", BURGUNDY, FRANCE
An extremely bright bouquet of fresh blossoms. Zippy acidity adds to the refreshing quality of the wine. Medium-bodied with notes of citrus fruits (lemon, orange, grapefruit), tropical notes and excellent balance. A very long finish that holds a note of vanilla bean.

DOMAINE COSTAL \$87

- 129 2019, LES TRUFFIERES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Generous, fleshy, and discreetly tropical, as if someone had planted pineapples in the Adirondacks. All its richness of flavor is then funneled down to a pinpoint focus on the snappy finish. The palate is left with a flinty note akin to gun smoke lingering after a shot.

PRINCIPE DE VIANA \$37

- 130 2019, NAVARRA, SPAIN
Lemon colour with greenish hues, Good acidity and freshness, presence of fruity notes. Smooth and harmonious, persistent and strong character. Expressive, citric and tropical aromas. Presence of vanilla undertones.

PINOT NOIR

WILLAMETTE VALLEY VINEYARDS \$50

2019, "WHOLE CLUSTER," WILLAMETTE, OREGON

- 151 Aromas of black cherry, raspberry, blackberry, and caramel. A fruit-forward and sweet entry lead to flavors that mirror aromas with the addition of cranberry, dark chocolate, and baking spices.

MCKINLAY \$50

2019, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON

- 153 Puc red brambleberry fruit, roses, sour cherry, mineral, a spine of cranberry acidity, and just a smidge of baking spice.

KEN WRIGHT \$52

2020, WILLAMETTE, WILLAMETTE, OREGON

- 154 Ripe rainier cherry, red plum and blackberry are nestled between notes of rose petal, cedar and turned earth. The wine is vibrant and lively on the palate with a generous finish.

GOODFELLOW \$100

2018, PUMPHOUSE BLOCK, TEMPERANCE HILL VINEYARD, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON

- 155 Red and black fruit, beautifully expressive, Nebbiolo-like, rocky, fresh roses, kitchen spices, balances deep fruits with tremendous tension. Structured and mineral with leather, amaro, exotic spice, cedar wood, tobacco, coffee and perfume. The classic iron fist in a velvet glove.

MARTIN WOOD \$75

2017, HAVLIN VINEYARD, VAN DUZER, OREGON

- 156 Dusty earth and spice, bright cranberry and cherry, medium frame with vibrant freshness and length. Resolved and integrated tannin structure.

AMMUNITION \$50

2017, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA

- 162 Ripe black cherry framed by a subtle oakiness dominate the aromas of this medium-to-full bodied Pinot Noir. Earthy cherry and strawberry flavors with subtle oak tones of vanilla spice that are embraced by smooth, silky tannins.

HARTFORD COURT \$81

2019 RUSSIAN RIVER, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

- 165 Aromas of black cherry, blueberry, black currant, allspice, and loam are followed by flavors of wild raspberries, dark berries, and a crushed rock minerality. The dense entry is followed by a sweet and juicy mouthfeel, supported by acidity, silky tannins, and a subtle earthy finish.

ANTHILL FARMS \$64

2018, SONOMA COAST, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA

- 167 Pure scents of cranberries, blackberries, black tea leaves, fragrant earth and garrigue. In the mouth, it's concentrated but light on its feet with a silky texture, floral fruits, seamless freshness and a long finish.

BELLE GLOS \$124

2018, LAS ALTURAS VINEYARD, SANTA LUCIA, CALIFORNIA

- 168 This powerful Pinot Noir offers intense aromas of black plum, purple flowers and toasty melted caramel. The palate is loaded with herbs and spice, from tarragon, sage and bay leaf to cardamom and anise, as well as a rich boysenberry-jam core.

FROMM \$80

2018, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

- 170 The cinnamon and clove spice get along graciously with the slinky red and blueberry fruit and floral characters. Tingly acidity on the palate makes the fruit pop. It's backed by savory, sappy notes and a talc-like cinch of tannins that hits just at the right spot.

JOSEPH DROUHIN \$74

2016, COTE DE NUITS VILLAGES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE

- 191 A delicious red Burgundy, with harmonious flavors. Bright ruby color. On the nose, intense aromas of wild cherry, licorice and mild spices, evolving towards notes of undergrowth and mushroom.

JOSEPH DROUHIN \$74

2016, CHOREY LES BEAUNE BOURGOGNE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE

192 Bright, clear red colour. Aromas are surprising in their intensity and fruit. On the palate, a tender, supple, graceful, round body. Very flavourful in the aftertaste, with a hint of blackberry jam. When the wine gets older, wild blackberry is the dominant aroma.

JEAN-CLAUDE RAGNAUDOT \$75

2017, COTE DE BEAUNE, FRANCE, MARANGES 1ST CRU LES CLOS ROUSSOTS

194 An old-fashioned, rustic style of red Burgundy, deep and powerful with a firm, earthy tannin. For immediate consumption, it possesses a clayey grip.

DOMAINE EDMUND CORNU & FILS \$85

2018, "LES BARRIGARDS" BOURGOGNE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE

195 Rich and softly textured, with an upright structure of dryness from a year in wood. The red fruits offer the potential for attractive liveliness in the future.

DOMAINE PIERRE GUILLEMOT \$120

2018, BURGUNDY, FRANCE, SAVIGNY AUX SERPENTIÈRES, PREMIER CRU

197 Wafting from the glass with notes of smoky cherries, raspberries, rose petals, orange rind and warm spices. Medium to full-bodied, sumptuous and layered, it's lively and textural, with fine depth at the core, powdery tannins, and a perfumed finish.

LIGHT BODIED REDS

- 200 **FEUDI DI SAN GREGORIO** \$50
2017, AGLIANICO, CAMPANIA, ITALY
Chewy and savory, this smooth young red doles out ripe black-cherry, juicy blackberry, licorice and baking-spice flavors. It's generous and ready to enjoy, with polished tannins.
- 201 **CUSUMANO** \$38
2019, NERO D' AVOLA, SICILY, ITALY
Lots of fruity, dark-cherry aromas and flavors with undertones of lemon peel and zest. It's medium-bodied with firm tannins and a lightly chewy texture at the finish.
- 202 **BEN MARCO** \$46
2018, MELBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA
The freshness and saltiness to this is fantastic. Medium-to full-bodied, firm and super silky with an extremely long and driven finish. Vertical and focused.
- 203 **VAGLIO** \$44
2017, TEMPLE, MELBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA
Electric purple, with aromas of fresh plums, wild raspberries, lilacs, and sweet spice. Bold and forward, a sweet core of black cherry fruit ensconced in plush tannins. Chewy and ripe, but with a pleasantly lifted floral finish.
- 204 **MEMOIRE** \$34
2019, MALBEC, BORDEAUX, FRANCE
Intense ruby color with great brilliance. Vibrant nose of black fruits and slight aromas of spices. Full mouth feel, with crisp and a perfect balance. Long finish with careful tension that provides lingering pleasure.
- 206 **DOMAINE DE LA MADONE** \$45
2019, BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE
Aromas of fresh raspberries, black cherries and violets, plus an intense mineral overtone. Le Perreon shares the noble character of the most refined French Burgundy, as the red fruit flavors puts on weight with some time in the glass, adding density, complexity, and freshness.
- 208 **BACKSBERG** \$34
2018, PINOTAGE, SIMONSBERG, SOUTH AFRICA
Ripe mulberry and sweet strawberry flavors are complimented by subtle undertones of dried herbs. This Pinotage has a juicy mouth-feel with supple, tannins.
- 215 **CHATEAU SAINT ROCH** \$50
2017, KERBUCCIO, COTES DU ROUSSILLON, FRANCE
Ripe blackberries, melted chocolate, black cherries, and cured meat notes all emerge from this beautifully textured, layered, opulent wine that stays balanced and pure.
- 216 **CLOS ERASMUS** \$120
2018, LAUREL, PRIORAT, SPAIN
It's a bright translucent ruby color and has a perfumed and delicate nose with notes of orange peel and flowers; this is the most elegant and ethereal vintage of Laurel as far as I can remember, with red rather than black fruit and a kind of cranberry quality. The palate is medium-bodied, textured and fluid, with subtleness, balance and very fine tannins. The oak is perfectly integrated.
- 221 **ADA NADA** \$60
2018 SERENA, LANGHE NEBBIOLO, PIEDMONT, ITALY
Marked by an orange-red tint to its color, the classic appearance of Nebbiolo, the wine is far from timid, showing a firm backbone of tannins that are a clear indicator of the traditional bent of this multi-generational domaine.
- 224 **PRODUTTORI DEL BARBARESCO** \$105
2017, BARBARESCO DOCG, PIEDMONT, ITALY
Layers of aromatics woven together with tar, forested earth, dried cherry, and sweet tobacco. The palate is ripe and pure, with raspberry leather, tea leaf, and blood orange. It is mouth-filling, with fruit that is long and persistent, fine tannins, and a lifted finish.

AZIENDA AGRICOLA DIEGO CONTERNO \$124

- 227 2016, BAROLO DOCG, PIEDMONT, ITALY
A beautiful wine that offers a good bit of fruitiness allied to classic structure. The first burst of sweet red berry fruit is deceptive, as the wine feels approachable, but then the young Nebbiolo acids and tannins come through.

GD VAJRA \$90

- 228 2017, ALBE BAROLO, NEBBIOLO PIEDMONT, ITALY
Rose petals, rose hips, cherry stones on the nose, followed by delicate tones of Nebbiolo pomace, tar, cranberries and raspberries, mint, anise, gentle musk and a whiffle of white pepper. In the palate, it's fragrant and uplifting, yet disclosing a rich texture, a fresh but poised mid palate and velvety tannins.

DAMILANO \$132

- 229 2015, LECINQUEVIGI BAROLO, NEBBIOLO PIEDMONT, ITALY
Ruby red in color with orange reflections. An intense bouquet, with tertiary notes of rose, leather, tobacco and emerging notes of violet and tar. The palate is ample and embracing, with prevailing impressions of a soft, persistent long finish.

BOLD REDS

- PASANAU** \$52
263 2017, CEPS NOUS, GARNACHA, PRIORAT, SPAIN
Concentrated and voluptuous ripe fruit is complemented by strong minerality and wood spice on the nose and finish.
- CONDADO DE HAZA** \$53
265 2016, TEMPRANILLO, RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN
Lots of body, well integrated acidity, well-rounded tannins providing volume and persistence on the palate. The licorice aromas are present on the aftertaste.
- TINTO PESQUERA** \$82
266 2018, TEMPRANILLO, RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN
Pleasant fresh aromatics with red berry fruit notes, such as raspberries, coming through along with balsamic hints. The whole combines to offer a complex, serious wine.
- FLOR DE PINGUS** \$200
268 2018, TEMPRANILLO, RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN
A chunky and pretty wine with blueberries and blackberries and chocolate. Chewy tannins that are polished and fresh. Full-bodied. Round and sexy.
- PLUNGERHEAD** \$42
270 2018, OLD VINES, ZINFANDEL, LODI, CALIFORNIA
Aromas of brambly raspberry, fresh-from-the-oven cherry pie, cinnamon-infused tea, toasted cedar, and clove. The flavors start with touches of Bing cherry, sweetened cranberry, raspberry jam, caramel and toasted coconut.
- BADGERHOUND** \$40
271 2016, ZINFANDEL, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
Showing sweet, concentrated fruit in the mouth with plenty of oak, tannins and acidity to balance the ripeness. The finish is long, rich and intense.
- GREEN & RED** \$60
273 2018, CHILES CANYON, ZINFANDEL, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
Focused and zesty, with brooding blackberry, grilled dill and white pepper flavors that take on broad-shouldered tannins on the finish.
- TURLEY** \$60
274 2019, "OLD VINES" ZINFANDEL, CALIFORNIA
A ruby-purple color and bright, inviting red and blue berry fruits laced with notes of apricot and dried flowers. Medium-bodied, the palate is silky, soft, super fresh and approachable with understated but pure fruit character.
- ORIN SWIFT** \$95
276 2018, EIGHT YEARS IN THE DESERT, ZINFANDEL, CALIFORNIA
Deep garnet-purple colored, it comes roaring out of the glass with notions of baked black cherries, raspberry preserves, blueberry tart and potpourri plus hints of garrigue, tobacco leaf and cinnamon stick. Full-bodied, the richly fruited palate has a pleasantly chewy texture and loads of savory layers coming through on the finish.
- GAJA** \$225
279 2014, BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO DOCG, TUSCANY, ITALY
Botanical notes and fresh fruity aromas of sage, rosemary, red currant and pomegranate, followed by complimentary notes of clove and incense. On the palate, you immediately notice freshness and elegance. Stone fruits, such as pear and quince give way to a smooth, savory texture with vibrant acidity, silky tannins and long aftertaste.
- OWEN ROE** \$52
280 2019, EX UMBRIS, SYRAH, COLUMBIA VALLEY, WASHINGTON
Really attractive dark berries, smoked meat and wet earth. Some sweet tobacco. Complex aromas. Medium to full body, round and polished tannins.
- MARTIN WOODS** \$100
283 2019, THE ROCKS SYRAH, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON
Simply beautiful and intricately balanced. Lighter on the nose offering herbal notes of clove and coriander with a powerful palate of cranberry, blackberry and stewed plum. Full bodied and a plush finish. Worth every cent.
- DOMAINE DE LA GRANGE DES PERES** \$280
288 2016, VIN DE PAYS DE L'HÉRAULT, LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON, FRANCE
Cedar, leather, dark sunny blackberry with perfectly polished edges. Fine tannins perfectly balanced with shingly mature red apple, cooked quince and plum.

EBERLE \$60

2018, STEINBECK SYRAH, PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA

- 282 This wine is exotic and aromatic, full of dark red and purple fruits like plums and brambly blackberries, savory undertones of fresh game, perfectly integrated tannins, and fresh acidity. The finish is persistent and lengthy.

2017, THE FOOTBOLT, SHIRAZ, MCLAREN VALE, AUSTRALIA

- 285 Generously rich with amazing fruit weight and balanced, chewy tannins. Brimming with ripe red fruits and an underlying layer of subtle oak, as well as a hint of pepper.

SCHILD ESTATE \$45

2017, SHIRAZ, BAROSSA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA

- 286 Raspberry puree and black cherry flavors are the focus here, with accents of Earl Grey tea, amaretto and spice box. Shows terrific density to the tannins, which become appealingly chewy on the finish.

LES PALLIERES \$96

2015, TERRASSE DU DIABLE, GIGODONAS, FRANCE

- 289 Dark and focused, with cassis, blackberry and black currant fruit flavors spliced together, racing along atop mouthwatering bramble, lavender and rosemary accents. A bright iron streak pierces the finish, adding lift and range.

CHATEAU DE CHAINTRES \$86

2018, SAUMUR CHAMPIGNY, LOIRE, FRANCE

- 290 This Cabernet Franc is remarkably fresh, with fully ripe, snappy red fruits and beautifully integrated tannins, it is a testament to this appellation's capacity for producing elegant Cabernet Franc.

JANUIK \$52

2017, MERLOT, COLUMBIA VALLEY, WASHINGTON

- 295 Notes of dried herb, dark chocolate, cherry and cedar. Well-proportioned, slightly jammy red- and black-fruit flavors follow, supported by a lovely sense of structure and accented by plentiful barrel spices.

DUCKHORN \$125

2018, MERLOT, NAPA, CALIFORNIA

- 296 Aromas of ripe cherry and black raspberry, dusty tannins and supple texture, a lush and expansive expression of Napa Valley Merlot. Luxurious flavors of black plum, rhubarb crumble and chocolate-covered raspberry mingle with hints of graphite and clove on the long, vibrant finish.

The nose absolutely sings of warm blackcurrants, black cherries and mulberries plus fragrant suggestions of chocolate box, lilacs and licorice. Medium to full-bodied

305 2017, NAPA, CALIFORNIA

Displaying a deep garnet-purple color and nose of expressive blackberries, blueberries and pencil shavings plus lovely dried leaves, rose hip tea and fragrant earth nuances, this Cabernet Sauvignon is medium to full-bodied in the firm, taut, energetic and lively mouth, with grainy tannins and a long, earthy finish.

JORDAN \$125

306 2016, ALEXANDER VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

Showing an elegant structure, this historic wine is well integrated in terms of tannin and soft, supportive oak. Dried herb and clove mark the midpalate, adding seasoning and complex character to the current core.

MATTHIASSEN \$120

307 2017, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA, CALIFORNIA

The nose shows abundant red fruits, lots of bright cherry along with bramble-berries, such as blackberry, cranberry, mulberry, and framed with hints of mineral/herbal characters such as graphite, cedar, and pencil shavings. The palate is vibrant and fresh, with light tannin and beautiful acidity.

2016, VIGNA SAN FRANCESCO, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, DOC SICILIA, ITALY

316 Deep purple in color, aromas of red cherries and black fruits complement undertones of vanilla, black pepper, cinnamon, and mint. On the palate, it is silky, concentrated, elegant, and balanced with a persistent finish.

- 378 Impressive notes of redcurrants, cassis, leafy herbs, and cedar all emerge from the glass, and it's medium to full-bodied, has a solid spiciness of acidity, outstanding balance.

2016, L'HERMITAGE, GRAVES, FRANCE

- 383 A elegant wine with spicy notes of cloves, cinnamon, tobacco, and a touch of violets. Toasty notes of mocha and cocoa.

CHATEAU BELLES-GRAVES \$87

2015, LALANDE DE POMEROL, FRANCE

- 384 Medium-garnet color. Aromas of red currant, allspice berry, smoked paprika, cracked peppercorn and worn cedar. Succulent and juicy on the palate, with dense red fruit and subtle secondary layers of spices and wood consistent with the nose.

CLOS PETIT-CORBIN \$85

2018, GRAND CRU, SAINT-EMILION, FRANCE

- 396 Shows notes of dark fruit, cedar, baking spice, and wet forest floor, marked by well-integrated tannins and a lingering finish.

- 397 The smoke, almond, dark-berry and plum character is impressive. Full body, round and silky tannins and beautiful fruit and spice undertones. Plenty of coffee and cedar flavors at the end
