- GRUET \$42**
 30 NV BRUT, NEW MEXICO
 A crisp, and full-bodied sparkling wine, which has developed rich complexity and fine mousse. The allure of the toasty finish is a complement to the sophisticated apple and citrus flavor.
- DOMAINE CHANDON \$55**
 31 NV BRUT, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
 Nutty flavors with hints of brioche that build to a refreshingly dry finish. The wine delivers complex apple and pear characteristics accented by citrus spice over notes of almond and caramel in the bouquet.
- DOMAINE CHANDON \$60**
 32 NV, ROSE, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
 On the plate, the wine is creamy and seductive, with defined structure from addition of still Pinot Noir at tirage. The overall impression is one of bold vibrancy an impact from start to finish.
- ROEDERER \$75**
 33 NV ANDERSON VALLEY, CALIFORNIA
 An enticing, toasty, nutty aroma leads to crisp and complex flavors in this medium-bodied wine that is braced by good acidity and a fine bead of bubbles.
- MUMM BRUT \$72**
 34 NV NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA
 Ripe, full and concentrated, intriguing and complex nose of toast, coconut, hazelnut, mocha, toffee and oak spice. Deep and rich, and refreshing on the palate, its creamy textured, multilayered flavors of ripe Fuji apple, red plum, fresh cherry, vanilla and honeysuckle linger with a long, complex finish.
- MASHIO \$35**
 35 NV BRUT, PROSECCO, ITALY
 Light straw yellow in color with a lively froth. Features a bouquet of white beach and orange blossoms, fruit forward with peach and almond flavors.
- CONTRATTO \$90**
 36 2012 NOVECENTO CUVEE, SPUMANTE BRUT, PIEDMONT, ITALY
 This Cuvée Novecento offers a nose exploding with aromas of white flowers, mint and citrus fruits, combine with lively minerality and a clean and persistent finish, thanks to an extraordinary and surprising freshness despite its more than 84 months on the lees.
- DOMAINE DU PRIEURE \$50**
 37 NV 'LES CAVES DU PRIEURE' CREMANT DE BOURGOGNE, BRUT, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 Blending 70% Chardonnay with 30% Pinot Noir, a classic brut style, rich in racy minerals and floral aromas, with hints of honey, spiced apples and white peaches.
- FOREAU \$55**
 38 2013 VOUVRAY, BRUT, LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE
 Flavors of citrus and apple with fine bubbles on the palate. The balance is perfect and the length is incredible. On the nose, there are aromatics of grape, apple, and dark fruit.
- VEUVE CLICQUOT \$82**
 39 NV BRUT, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
 Perfect example of harmony between delicacy and power. Dominated by Pinot Noir, this wine has a firm structure, rounded with a touch of Pinot Meunier. Nearly a third of Chardonnay gives it the elegance and finesse needed for perfect balance.
- PERRIER-JOUET \$130**
 40 NV GRAND BRUT, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
 Meyer lemon peel, poached apricot and pastry cream notes are tightly meshed with a minerally underpinning and racy acidity in this vivacious Champagne. Creamy finish.
- MARIE COPINET \$60**
 41 NV CARACTERE ROSE 500ML, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
 The fabulously tempting colour is an absolute delight for the eyes. The nose is full of the fresh, exciting aromas of pink grapefruit, strawberries, violet and marsh-mallow. As it opens out the wine exudes a veritable cascade of red fruit aromas.

- LOS VASCOS \$30**
2020, CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE
51 Honeydew, lime and lychee-scented nose that also reveals hints of wild asparagus and fresh lemon verbena. On the palate, this extroverted wine is lively, fresh, and gentle.
- JOLIVET \$38**
2020, "ATTITUDE," LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE
52 A beautiful freshness in mouth, a frank attack, delicate green and lemon flavours, citrus fruits, green apple and kiwi aromas. The minerality gives a long finish to the wine, a smoothness and elegance.
- HONIG \$40**
2020, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
53 Bright, and fresh. The flavors and aromas are reminiscent of peaches, lemon curd, white grapefruit, and passion fruit with perfectly balanced notes of citrus and stone fruit. The fullness of the midpalate is complemented by a crisp, lengthy finish.

2018, RUSSIAN RIVER, CALIFORNIA
55 A rich expression of Russian River Valley fruit with notes of honeydew melon, tangerine, and citrus zest. Bright notes of floral honeysuckle, subtle barrel spice and flint balance the vibrant fruit-forward palate.

2020, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
56 A creamy, viscous entry adjourned in jasmine. Lemon pitch, grapefruit and tangerine present as lush and lengthy on the palate, balanced by fresh, persistent acidity.

2020, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
57 Elegant and precise, with juicy peach, melon and blood orange flavors on a supple frame. Orange blossom and lemon sherbet notes linger on the fresh finish.
- KOYLE COSTA \$38**
2020 LA FLOR, COLCHAGUA VALLEY, RAPEL VALLEY, CHILE
61 Presenting a pale, steely yellow profile in the glass, while aromas include lime, rue, grapefruit and gunpowder. Featuring good fat in the mouth and heightened freshness, it ends with a lime-infused finish.
- LES HAUTS DE LAGARDE \$40**
2020 BLANC, AOP BORDEAUX, FRANCE
65 This is a delicious, ripe wine that is packed with apricot, apple and pear fruits. It is tangy and freshly fruity. The bright, rich fruit continues right through this wine that is ready to drink now.

 2020, "VISION" GRUNER VELTLINER, NIEDERÖSTERREICH, AUSTRIA
 90 The creamy freshness of green pear on the nose also has a hint of lemon peel. The body is light but zesty, easy but bright, fruit-driven but also rather peppery. It is a lovely, light offering.
- ANNE PICHON \$47**
 2020, "SAUVAGE," VIOGNIER, RHONE, FRANCE
 91 Clean and racy, and bright, with notes of green apple, grapefruit and stone. Pointed, with a metallic finish.
- TASCA D'ALMERITA \$45**
 2019 CATARRATTO ANTISA, D.O.C SICILIA, ITALY
 92 A brilliant lemon-green, Antisa Catarratto explodes with ripe citrus and stone fruit blossom. On the palate, the wine is crisp and firm with a pleasant broadness from the lees contact. A clean and balanced finish.
- DURIN RIVIERA \$42**
 2019, PIGATO, LIGURIA, ITALY
 93 Ripe and inviting on the palate, notes of white peaches and juicy lemons return alongside compelling touches of wildflower honey, white pepper, sunflower seeds, and fresh herbs. Salty minerals dust the lips and inner cheeks as the wine lingers on its long, brisk, and joyful finish.
- BIANCHI \$32**
 2019, PINOT GRIGIO, CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA
 94 Focusing on blossomy fruit and varietal character. Aromas of honeysuckle, melon and kiwi are enhanced by minty overtones. Full-bodied, the finish is crisp, clean and satisfying.
- CHAMPALOU \$51**
 2020, VOUVRAY, TOURAINE, LOIRE, FRANCE
 95 On the palate, it's luscious but not cloying, with ripe tropical and stone fruit tastes combined with citrus and floral notes. It lingers in the mouth with refreshing acidity and minerals.
- PINE RIDGE \$40**
 2020, CHININ BLANC-VIOGNIER, CLARKSBURG, CALIFORNIA
 96 Boasting a bouquet of honeysuckle, orange blossoms, rub grapefruit, white peach, and jasmine tea. The entry is both bright and mouth filling, exhibiting refreshing acidity and roundness, opening to flavors of tangerine, lime, and lemon curd, lemongrass, ginger, white peach, and green apple.
- LA CLOSERIE DES LYS \$32**
 2019, LES FRUITIERES ROSE, LIMOUX, LANGUEDOC, SUD DE FRANCE, FRANCE
 97 This pale rosé blends syrah, cinsault, grenache, and merlot from Limoux. Fruit for the rosé comes from the highest elevation plots, hence the inherent freshness here. Wild strawberries, grapefruit, orange, and watermelon ride a slender, juicy frame, finishing snappy and bright. Lovely food-friendly or solo sipping pink.
- DOMAINE DE COURON \$32**
 2020, ROSE, ARDECHE, RHONE, FRANCE
 98 Soft and stylish with an endlessly refreshing palate of summer cherry, watermelon and passion fruit flavors. Clean with good fruit-filled body and a dry finish.
- SARACCO \$36**
 2020, MOSCATO D'ASTI, PIEDMONT, SPAIN
 99 Straw yellow with greenish hues, fine perlage, intense orange blossom, peach and thyme. Taste: intense, elegant and lingering. The sweet sensations are well balanced with a pleasant acidity and fruity aromas.
- DOMAINE DU VIEUX TELEGRAPHE \$160**
 2019 LA CRAU, CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, FRANCE
 100 Lemon, stone fruit, apricot and white peach on the nose. Pale gold with a nutty palate. Slightly oily, medium acidity, medium body, well integrated and well balanced.
- CHATEAU D'EPIRE \$75**
 2018 MOELLEUX GRAND CRU, SAVENNIERES, FRANCE
 102 Wonderfully honeyed, sweet Savennières wine has an alluring bouquet of stewed pears, beeswax and fleurs blanches and a ripe, rounded, terrifically textured. Palate of grilled nuts and orchard fruit with an underlying acidity and subtle mineral nuances.

CHARDONNAY

- AU BON CLIMAT \$48**
 111 2019, SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA
 This barrel fermented, full-bodied Chardonnay has mouth-filling citrus fruit and a palate cleansing, bright finish.
- MORGAN \$58**
 112 2019, HIGHLAND, SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS, MONTEREY, CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA
 Aromas of pear, clove, green apple, and caramel. On the palate, aromas are complemented by a light touch of Meyer lemon, graham cracker, and nutmeg. Incredibly food-friendly, this Highland Chardonnay is a perfect match for cream-sauced pastas, roast pork, and seafood.
- CHALK HILL \$48**
 113 2019, "RUSSIAN RIVER," SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
 Hints of baking spices and warm apple pie meld together to meet the nose. The fruit manifests rich textural body with extended notes of toasted hazelnut, vanilla custard and creme brulee that rein in the perfect balance of acidity and minerality.
- ROMBAUER \$84**
 117 2020, CARNEROS, CALIFORNIA
 Pale yellow with a green tinge to the hue. Aromas of yellow peach, mango with a slight citrus note intertwine seamlessly with vanilla and spice. The palate is rich and round, with the mango and vanilla fighting for the limelight, while the cream texture, vanilla and slight butter combine seamlessly.
- FEL \$72**
 118 2018, ANDERSON VALLEY, CALIFORNIA
 Fresh, vibrant fruit aromas and flavors drive this full-bodied and well-balanced wine. It floods the palate with flavors of crisp apple, ripe pear and a touch of pineapple while subtle hints of baking spice play in the background.
- LOUIS LATOUR \$54**
 126 2018, "MANTAGNY LA GRAND ROCHE," BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 Crisp, bright, unoaked premier cru Montagny with more than a little similarity to a warmer-vintage Chablis. Peach and ripe melon fruit flavours, combined with a succulent texture and saline, stony finish.
- DOMAINE CHEVEAU \$60**
 128 2018, MACON SOLUTRE-POUILLY "SUR LE MONT", BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 An extremely bright bouquet of fresh blossoms. Zippy acidity adds to the refreshing quality of the wine. Medium bodied with notes of citrus fruits (lemon, orange, grapefruit), tropical notes and excellent balance. A very long finish that holds a note of vanilla bean.
- DOMAINE COSTAL \$87**
 129 2019, LES TRUFFIERES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 Generous, fleshy, and discreetly tropical, as if someone had planted pineapples in the Adirondacks. All its richness of flavor is then funneled down to a pinpoint focus on the snappy finish. The palate is left with a flinty note akin to gun smoke lingering after a shot.
- FRANCINE ET OLIVIER \$74**
 130 2019, SAVARY CHABLIS, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 Lemon zest, star fruit, wet stone, and white flowers all coat the palate in a bone-dry, vitalizing, and immensely enjoyable wine.
- CAPITAIN-GAGNEROT \$74**
 131 2019, BOURGOGNE HAUTES-CÔTES DE BEAUNE LES GUEULOTTES, FRANCE
 Delicious and malolactic buttery soft notes with balanced acidity, butter and limestone. Fresh sweet lemon juice and apple.
- DOMAINE GUY ROBIN ET FILS \$84**
 132 2018, CHABLIS VIELLES, FRANCE
 Opening with orange blossoms, chamomile, grapefruit, orange peel, persimmons, seashells, flint, and lemon verbena. On the palate, the wine shows off its body with green apples, apricots, and ginger accented with brioche and roasted almonds. The wine's bright acidity balances the slightly creamy mouthfeel and continues into a long, zesty finish.
- ALBERT BICHOT \$78**
 135 2019, POUILLY-FUISSE, MACONNAIS, FRANCE
 This wine features a lively, aromatic nose with predominant notes of white fruit and spices, underpinned by a subtle touch of oak and vanilla. Mineral on the palate with a good balance between acidity and roundness. Lovely length

PINOT NOIR

- WILLAMETTE VALLEY VINEYARDS \$50**
 151 2020, "WHOLE CLUSTER," WILLAMETTE, OREGON
 Fruity and forward, this bursts forth with candied cherries, marionberry jam and blueberry compote. Behind that wall of fruit are light acidity and just enough phenolic punch to keep the flavors ringing through the finish.
- MCKINLAY \$50**
 153 2020, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON
 Aromas of lack cherry, cream of cherry, vanilla clove, cherry blossom, lavender, and Pinot funk. Flavors of vanilla, cardamom, pomegranate, raspberry, cherry with a French oak finish.
- KEN WRIGHT \$55**
 154 2021, "WILLAMETTE VALLEY", WILLAMETTE, OREGON
 Ripe rainier cherry, red plum and blackberry are nestled between notes of rose petal, cedar and turned earth. The wine is vibrant and lively on the palate with a generous finish.
- ARCHERY SUMMET \$85**
 155 2020, "DUNDEE HILLS" WILLAMETTE, OREGON
 A medley of graphite, spice and crushed red strawberries waft from the glass. On the palate, there's opulent fruit and signature Dundee Hills spices like allspice, cardamom and sandalwood. The palate is loaded, with fresh strawberry jam and an underlying earthiness taking the lead. Structurally, there are soft oak tannins that give way to an exquisitely long and balanced finish.
- MARTIN WOOD \$100**
 156 2019, "BEDNARIK VINEYARD", WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON.
 Opens to aromas of strawberries, raspberries and red cherry candy with nuances of lilac, dried herbs and blood orange. The medium-bodied palate is silky and expressive, offering a great balance of herbs, fruits and spices with a gently chalky frame and long, uplifted finish.
- FAILLA \$66**
 157 2021 WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON
 Bright and aromatic with notes of pomegranates, orange zest, bright cherries, and dried herbs. This wine perfectly emphasizes the essence of the Willamette Valley.
- AMMUNITION \$58**
 162 2017, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
 Ripe black cherry framed by a subtle oakiness dominate the aromas of this medium-to-full bodied Pinot Noir. Earthy cherry and strawberry flavors with subtle oak tones of vanilla spice that are embraced by smooth, silky tannins.
- HARTFORD COURT \$81**
 165 2019 RUSSIAN RIVER, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
 Aromas of black cherry, blueberry, black currant, allspice, and loam are followed by flavors of wild raspberries, dark berries, and a crushed rock minerality. The dense entry is followed by a sweet and juicy mouthfeel, supported by acidity, silky tannins, and a subtle earthy finish.
- BOEN \$68**
 166 2020 TRI COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
 Dark Plum in color with ruby red highlights. On the nose, luscious notes of raspberry swirl along side dark plum notes accompanied by hints of rosemary and sage. Rich and well balanced with bright blackberry, Bing cherry, dark chocolate and a hint of caramel on the palate.
- ANTHILL FARMS \$64**
 167 2020, SONOMA COAST, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
 Pure scents of cranberries, blackberries, black tea leaves, fragrant earth and garrigue. In the mouth, it's concentrated but light on its feet with a silky texture, floral fruits, seamless freshness and a long finish.
- BELLE GLOS \$120**
 168 2020, CLARK & TELEPHONE, SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA
 Rich scarlet color, with aromas of brown spice, caramel and soft tea. The velvety palate offers flavors of bright red fruit, warm spices and sweet oak, supported by firm acidity and refined tannins.
- HIRSCH ESTATE \$204**
 169 2018, EAST RIDGE PINOT NOIR, SONOMA COAST, CALIFORNIA
 Juicy pomegranate, black tea and rocky tannin. Textured, it is both savory in nature and bursting in acidity, providing a lengthy freshness as it goes.

SEA SMOKE \$200

- 170 2019 "TEN" STA RITA HILLS, CALIFORNIA
The aromas begin with notes of black cherry, tuberose and fig, then a myriad of savory spices, and a hint of jasmine. Firm, mature tannins, followed by a long, velvety finish

ALTO LIMAY \$45

- 171 2018, PATAGONIA, ARGENTINA
Vibrant red in the glass with fresh floral aromas mingling with red currants, strawberries, and raspberries. A medium-bodied pinot noir with ultrafine tannins and a refreshing balance between fruit, mushroom, and mineral notes, with hints of spice and cocoa

FROMM \$80

- 172 2018, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZELAND
The cinnamon and clove spice get along graciously with the slinky red and blueberry fruit and floral characters. Tingly acidity on the palate makes the fruit pop. It's backed by savory, sappy notes and a talc-like cinch of tannins that hits just at the right spot.

JOSEPH DROUHIN \$74

- 192 2016, CHOREY LES BEAUNE BOURGOGNE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Bright, clear red colour. Aromas are surprising in their intensity and fruit. On the palate, a tender, supple, graceful, round body. Very flavorful in the aftertaste, with a hint of blackberry jam. When the wine gets older, wild blackberry is the dominant aroma.

JEAN-CLAUDE RAGNAUDOT \$75

- 194 2017, COTE DE BEAUNE, FRANCE, MARANGES 1ST CRU LES CLOS ROUSSOTS
An old-fashioned, rustic style of red Burgundy, deep and powerful with a firm, earthy tannin. For immediate consumption, it possesses a clayey grip.

DOMAINE EDMUND CORNU & FILS \$85

- 195 2018, "LES BARRIGARDS" BOURGOGNE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Rich and softly textured, with an upright structure of dryness from a year in wood. The red fruits offer the potential for attractive liveliness in the future.

DOMAINE PIERRE GUILLEMOT \$120

- 197 2018, SAVIGNY AUX SERPENTIÉRES, PREMIER CRU, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Wafting from the glass with notes of smoky cherries, raspberries, rose petals, orange rind and warm spices. Medium to full-bodied, sumptuous and layered, it's lively and textural, with fine depth at the core, powdery tannins, and a perfumed finish.

DOMAINE COMTESSE DE CHERISEY \$246

- 198 2017, LA GENELOTTE BLAGNY PREMIER CRU, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Blagny 1er Cru La Genelotte is a monopole vineyard, the only producer of this vineyard which is very rare in Burgundy. Showcasing the oldest vines of this property. Pinot Noir planted in 1934, this wine has enormous aging potential and will be an out of this world experience in years to come.

LIGHT BODIED REDS

- 200 **FEUDI DI SAN GREGORIO \$50**
 2017, AGLIANICO, CAMPANIA, ITALY
 Chewy and savory, this smooth young red doles out ripe black-cherry, juicy blackberry, licorice and baking-spice flavors. It's generous and ready to enjoy, with polished tannins.
- 201 **CUSUMANO \$38**
 2019, NERO D' AVOLA, SICILY, ITALY
 Lots of fruity, dark-cherry aromas and flavors with undertones of lemon peel and zest. It's medium-bodied with firm tannins and a lightly chewy texture at the finish.
- 203 **BODEGA GARZON \$42**
 2020, MARSELAN, URUGUAY
 Brooding nose with lots of blackberries, tar, hot stones and violets. There's a hint of dried black fruit, too. A full-bodied red, showing a solid mid-palate, laden with rich and supple blackberry fruit and silky tannins. Just very slightly potent on the nose.
- 205 **BEN MARCO \$46**
 2019, MELBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA
 The freshness and saltiness to this is fantastic. Medium-to full-bodied, firm and super silky with an extremely long and driven finish. Vertical and focused.
- 206 **VAGLIO \$44**
 2018, TEMPLE, MELBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA
 Electric purple, with aromas of fresh plums, wild raspberries, lilacs, and sweet spice. Bold and forward, a sweet core of black cherry fruit ensconced in plush tannins. Chewy and ripe, but with a pleasantly lifted floral finish.
- 207 **PIATTELLI VINEYARDS \$50**
 2018, GRAND RESERVE, MALBEC, ARGENTINA
 Ripe dark-berry aromas come with warm notes of leather and game. The palate of this wine is bold but energetic and healthy. Black plum, raspberry and currant flavors are supported by modest oak spice. Oaky flavors are prominent on the finish.
- 208 **MEMOIRE \$34**
 2019, MALBEC, BORDEAUX, FRANCE
 Intense ruby color with great brilliance. Vibrant nose of black fruits and slight aromas of spices. Full mouth feel, with crisp and a perfect balance. Long finish with careful tension that provides lingering pleasure.
- 210 **DOMAINE DE LA MADONE \$45**
 2018, BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE
 Aromas of fresh raspberries, black cherries and violets, plus an intense mineral overtone. Le Perreon shares the noble character of the most refined French Burgundy, as the red fruit flavors puts on weight with some time in the glass, adding density, complexity, and freshness.
- 212 **TOUR DE PIERRES \$51**
 2019, ERMITAGE DU PIC SAINT LOUP
 The robe is crimson and purple in appearance. The nose is spicy (white pepper), mint, cocoa, red fruits. The mouth is full-bodied, balanced, with notes of pepper and licorice. The tannins are still tight, the length bodes well for the future.
- 214 **DOMAINE HAUVETTE \$115**
 2012 "AMETHYST ROUGE", LES BAUX DE PROVENCE, RHONE, FRANCE
 Vibrant and juicy - almost blackcurrant jammy. On the palate it is much drier, with dusty tannins and a silky texture. There is a finely-wrought fruit quality and good length. Balanced and very classy.
- 215 **BACKSBERG \$34**
 2018, PINOTAGE, SIMONSBURG, SOUTH AFRICA
 Ripe mulberry and sweet strawberry flavors are complimented by subtle undertones of dried herbs. This Pinotage has a juicy mouth-feel with supple, tannins.
- 218 **DOMAINE DU GRANGEON CHATUS \$54**
 2016, COTEAUX DE L'ARDECHE, FRANCE
 Ample, violet-laced blackberry fruits, scorched earth, tar, graphite and licorice to go with a medium-bodied, structured, yet elegant profile on the palate.

LIGHT BODIED REDS

- ADA NADA \$60**
 2019, "SERENA", LANGHE NEBBIOLO, PIEDMONT, ITALY
 Marked by an orange-red tint to its color, the classic appearance of Nebbiolo, the wine is far from timid, showing a firm backbone of tannins that are a clear indicator of the traditional bent of this multi-generational domain.
- LUIGI \$63**
 2018, PIRA NEBBIOLO PIEDMONT, ITALY
 Ripeness with cherry skin, wild berry, pressed rose and some iron-rich soil. These results are simple and sharp, rendering an authentic and naked expression of the Nebbiolo grape.
- PRODUTTORI DEL BARBARESCO \$105**
 2017, BARBARESCO DOCG, PIEDMONT, ITALY
