- GRUET \$42**
 30 NV BRUT, NEW MEXICO
 A crisp, and full-bodied sparkling wine, which has developed rich complexity and fine mousse. The allure of the toasty finish is a complement to the sophisticated apple and citrus flavor.
- DOMAINE CHANDON \$55**
 31 NV BRUT, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
 Nutty flavors with hints of brioche that build to a refreshingly dry finish. The wine delivers complex apple and pear characteristics accented by citrus spice over notes of almond and caramel in the bouquet.
- DOMAINE CHANDON \$60**
 32 NV, ROSE, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
 On the plate, the wine is creamy and seductive, with defined structure from addition of still Pinot Noir at tirage. The overall impression is one of bold vibrancy an impact from start to finish.
- ROEDERER \$75**
 33 NV ANDERSON VALLEY, CALIFORNIA
 An enticing, toasty, nutty aroma leads to crisp and complex flavors in this medium-bodied wine that is braced by good acidity and a fine bead of bubbles.
- MUMM BRUT \$72**
 34 NV NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA
 Ripe, full and concentrated, intriguing and complex nose of toast, coconut, hazelnut, mocha, toffee and oak spice. Deep and rich, and refreshing on the palate, its creamy textured, multilayered flavors of ripe Fuji apple, red plum, fresh cherry, vanilla and honeysuckle linger with a long, complex finish.

 35 NV
 Fragrant, with enticing aromas of apple and peach. Refreshing and dry with crisp fruit flavors.
- CONTRATTO \$90**
 36 2012 NOVECENTO CUVÉE, SPUMANTE BRUT, PIEDMONT, ITALY
 This Cuvée Novecento offers a nose exploding with aromas of white flowers, mint and citrus fruits, combine with lively minerality and a clean and persistent finish, thanks to an extraordinary and surprising freshness despite its more than 84 months on the lees.
- DOMAINE DU PRIEURE \$50**
 37 NV 'LES CAVES DU PRIEURE' CREMANT DE BOURGOGNE, BRUT, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 Blending 70% Chardonnay with 30% Pinot Noir, a classic brut style, rich in racy minerals and floral aromas, with hints of honey, spiced apples and white peaches.
- FOREAU \$50**
 38 2013 VOUVRAY, BRUT, LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE
 Flavors of citrus and apple with fine bubbles on the palate. The balance is perfect and the length is incredible. On the nose, there are aromatics of grape, apple, and dark fruit.
- VEUVE CLICQUOT \$82**
 39 NV BRUT, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
 Perfect example of harmony between delicacy and power. Dominated by Pinot Noir, this wine has a firm structure, rounded with a touch of Pinot Meunier. Nearly a third of Chardonnay gives it the elegance and finesse needed for perfect balance.
- PERRIER-JOUET \$130**
 40 NV GRAND BRUT, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
 Meyer lemon peel, poached apricot and pastry cream notes are tightly meshed with a minerally underpinning and racy acidity in this vivacious Champagne, Creamy finish.
- MARIE COPINET \$60**
 41 NV CARACTERE ROSE 500ML, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
 The fabulously tempting colour is an absolute delight for the eyes. The nose is full of the fresh, exciting aromas of pink grapefruit, strawberries, violet and marsh-mallow. As it opens out the wine exudes a veritable cascade of red fruit aromas.

LOS VASCOS \$30

- 61 2021, CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE
Honeydew, lime and lychee-scented nose that also reveals hints of wild asparagus and fresh lemon verbena. On the palate, this extroverted wine is lively, fresh, and gentle.

JOLIVET \$38

- 62 2021, "ATTITUDE," LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE
A beautiful freshness in mouth, a frank attack, delicate green and lemon flavours, citrus fruits, green apple and kiwi aromas. The minerality gives a long finish to the wine, a smoothness and elegance.

HONIG \$40

- 63 2022, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
An enticing mix of honeysuckle, peach and tropical fruit aromas to a luxurious blend of floral, stone fruit and a mélange of citrus flavors on the palate. The wine is simultaneously elegant and rich, perfectly balanced from the gorgeous nose all the way through the lengthy, layered finish.

- 65 2018, RUSSIAN RIVER, CALIFORNIA
A rich expression of Russian River Valley fruit with notes of honeydew melon, tangerine, and citrus zest. Bright notes of floral honeysuckle, subtle barrel spice and flint balance the vibrant fruit-forward palate.

GROTH \$53

- 66 2019, NAPA, CALIFORNIA
With a hearty helping of 18% Sémillon, this white has a creamy, viscous entry adorned in jasmine. Lemon pith, grapefruit and tangerine present as lush and lengthy on the palate, balanced by fresh, persistent acidity.

DRY CREEK \$42

- 67 2021, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
Vibrant and expressive, with notes of tangerine, peach and dried pineapple. Sleek and refreshingly acidic, this shows details of dried flowers and citrus zest, with the aromatics lingering effortlessly on the long, fresh finish.

- 71 2020 LA FLOR, COLCHAGUA VALLEY, RAPEL VALLEY, CHILE
Presenting a pale, steely yellow profile in the glass, while aromas include lime, rue, grapefruit and gunpowder. Featuring good fat in the mouth and heightened freshness, it ends with a lime-infused finish.

- 75 2020 BLANC, AOP BORDEAUX, FRANCE
This is a delicious, ripe wine that is packed with apricot, apple and pear fruits. It is tangy and freshly fruity. The bright, rich fruit continues right through this wine that is ready to drink now.

 2020, "VISION" GRUNER VELTLINER, NIEDERÖSTERREICH, AUSTRIA
 90 Delicate fresh green apple fruity aromas, with flavors of lemon, lime and peaches. It has a solid fruit core, rich in finesse, with beautiful length and mineral tones.
- ANNE PICHON \$47**
 2020, "SAUVAGE," VIOGNIER, RHONE, FRANCE
 91 Clean and racy, and bright, with notes of green apple, grapefruit and stone. Pointed, with a metallic finish.
- TASCA D'ALMERITA \$45**
 2019 CATARRATTO ANTISA, D.O.C SICILIA, ITALY
 92 A brilliant lemon-green, Antisa Catarratto explodes with ripe citrus and stone fruit blossom. On the palate, the wine is crisp and firm with a pleasant broadness from the lees contact. A clean and balanced finish.
- ARCHERY SUMMIT \$45**
 2021, "VIRETON" PINOT GRIS, WILLAMETTE, OREGON.
 93 Touts bright citrus notes, a clean minerality, and a playful acidity. Dried flowers and citrus zest fill out the nose while the palate reminds of fresh pear, kiwi, and lime.

 2020, PINOT GRIGIO, CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA
 94 The mouthfeel is soft and supple, and soon we are flooded with flavors of honeydew melon, Asian pear, baked apple, and Meyer lemon. With a clean and dry finish.
- CHAMPALOU \$51**
 2020, VOUVRAY, TOURAINE, LOIRE, FRANCE
 95 On the palate, it's luscious but not cloying, with ripe tropical and stone fruit tastes combined with citrus and floral notes. It lingers in the mouth with refreshing acidity and minerals.
- PINE RIDGE \$40**
 2020, CHININ BLANC-VIOGNIER, CLARKSBURG, CALIFORNIA
 96 Boasting a bouquet of honeysuckle, orange blossoms, rub grapefruit, white peach, and jasmine tea. The entry is both bright and mouth filling, exhibiting refreshing acidity and roundness, opening to flavors of tangerine, lime, and lemon curd, lemongrass, ginger, white peach, and green apple.

 2020, MOSCATO D'ASTI, PIEDMONT, SPAIN
 99 Straw yellow with greenish hues, fine perlage, intense orange blossom, peach and thyme. Taste: intense, elegant and lingering. The sweet sensations are well balanced with a pleasant acidity and fruity aromas.
- DOMAINE DU VIEUX TELEGRAPHE \$160**
 2019 LA CRAU, CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, FRANCE
 100 Lemon, stone fruit, apricot and white peach on the nose. Pale gold with a nutty palate. Slightly oily, medium acidity, medium body, well integrated and well balanced.
- AMAVI \$50 (4)**
 2019 SEMILLON, WALLA WALLA, WASHINGTON
 102 Notes of honeysuckle, beeswax, passion fruit, spice on the nose. Opens with pear, golden delicious apple and lemon custard mouthwatering acidity and a refreshingly balanced finish.
- CHATEAU D'EPIRE \$75**
 2018 MOELLEUX GRAND CRU, SAVENNIERES, FRANCE
 104 Wonderfully honeyed, sweet Savennières wine has an alluring bouquet of stewed pears, beeswax and fleurs blanches and a ripe, rounded, terrifically textured. Palate of grilled nuts and orchard fruit with an underlying acidity and subtle mineral nuances.

CHARDONNAY

- 111 **AU BON CLIMAT \$48**
 2019, SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA
 This barrel fermented, full bodied Chardonnay has mouth filling citrus fruit and a palate cleansing, bright finish
- 112 **MORGAN \$58**
 2019, HIGHLAND, SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS, MONTEREY, CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA
 Aromas of pear, clove, green apple, and caramel. On the palate, aromas are complemented by a light touch of Meyer lemon, graham cracker, and nutmeg. Incredibly food-friendly, this Highland Chardonnay is a perfect match for cream-sauced pastas, roast pork, and seafood.
- 113 **Chalk Hill \$48**
 2019, "RUSSIAN RIVER," SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
 Hints of baking spices and warm apple pie meld together to meet the nose. The fruit manifests rich textural body with extended notes of toasted hazelnut, vanilla custard and creme brulee that rein in the perfect balance of acidity and minerality.
- 117 **ROMBAUER \$84**
 2021, CARNEROS, CALIFORNIA
 Ripe peach, citrus fruits, spice, and pie crust aromas all mingle and lift from the glass. The citrus, supported by notes of apricot, continues on the palate which is concentrated with a rich, creamy middle palate, and strong supporting acidity. The finish is long and marked with hints of vanilla.
- 118 **FEL \$72**
 2018, ANDERSON VALLEY, CALIFORNIA
 Fresh, vibrant fruit aromas and flavors drive this full-bodied and well-balanced wine. It floods the palate with flavors of crisp apple, ripe pear and a touch of pineapple while subtle hints of baking spice play in the background.
- 126 **LOUIS LATOUR \$57**
 2018, "MANTAGNY LA GRAND ROCHE," BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 Crisp, bright, unoaked premier cru Montagny with more than a little similarity to a warmer-vintage Chablis. Peach and ripe melon fruit flavours, combined with a succulent texture and saline, stony finish.
- 128 **DOMAINE CHEVEAU \$60**
 2018, MACON SOLUTRE-POUILLY "SUR LE MONT", BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 An extremely bright bouquet of fresh blossoms. Zippy acidity adds to the refreshing quality of the wine. Medium bodied with notes of citrus fruits (lemon, orange, grapefruit), tropical notes and excellent balance. A very long finish that holds a note of vanilla bean.
- 129 **DOMAINE COSTAL \$87**
 2019, LES TRUFFIERES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 Generous, fleshy, and discreetly tropical, as if someone had planted pineapples in the Adirondacks. All its richness of flavor is then funneled down to a pinpoint focus on the snappy finish. The palate is left with a flinty note akin to gun smoke lingering after a shot.
- 130 **FRANCINE ET OLIVIER \$74**
 2019, SAVARY CHABLIS, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
 Lemon zest, star fruit, wet stone, and white flowers all coat the palate in a bone-dry, vitalizing, and immensely enjoyable wine.
- 131 **CAPITAIN-GAGNEROT \$74**
 2019, BOURGOGNE HAUTES-CÔTES DE BEAUNE LES GUEULOTTES, FRANCE
 Delicious and malolactic buttery soft notes with balanced acidity, butter and limestone. Fresh sweet lemon juice and apple.
- 132 **DOMAINE GUY ROBIN ET FILS \$84**
 2020, CHABLIS VIELLES, FRANCE
 Opening with orange blossoms, chamomile, grapefruit, orange peel, persimmons, seashells, flint, and lemon verbena. On the palate, the wine shows off its body with green apples, apricots, and ginger accented with brioche and roasted almonds. The wine's bright acidity balances the slightly creamy mouthfeel and continues into a long, zesty finish.
- 135 **ALBERT BICHOT \$78**
 2019, POUILLY-FUISSE, MACONNAIS, FRANCE
 This wine features a lively, aromatic nose with predominant notes of white fruit and spices, underpinned by a subtle touch of oak and vanilla. Mineral on the palate with a good balance between acidity and roundness. Lovely length

- WILLAMETTE VALLEY VINEYARDS \$50**
 151 2021, "WHOLE CLUSTER," WILLAMETTE, OREGON
 Opens with aromas and flavors of raspberry and strawberry preserves accented by savory cardamom spice and earth. On the Palate: Indicative of the warm and even growing season, the palate is lush and full-bodied, giving way to a smooth finish.
- MCKINLAY \$50**
 153 2021, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON
 Aromas of lack cherry, cream of cherry, vanilla clove, cherry blossom, lavender, and Pinot funk. Flavors of vanilla, cardamom, pomegranate, raspberry, cherry with a French oak finish.
- KEN WRIGHT \$57**
 154 2020 WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON
 Floral notes of magnolia, rose and candied red fruits play with gentle touches of cinnamon and clove on the nose. Flavors of generous red cherry, raspberry, and plum swirl with subtle notes of vanilla cream. This wine graces the entire palate with smoothly textured tannins and leaves it with a lucisusly clean finish.
- ARCHERY SUMMIT \$85**
 155 2020, "DUNDEE HILLS" WILLAMETTE, OREGON
 A medley of graphite, spice and crushed red strawberries waft from the glass. On the palate, there's opulent fruit and signature Dundee Hills spices like allspice, cardamom and sandalwood. The palate is loaded, with fresh strawberry jam and an underlying earthiness taking the lead. Structurally, there are soft oak tannins that give way to an exquisitely long and balanced finish.
- MARTIN WOOD \$100**
 156 2019, "BEDNARIK VINEYARD", WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON.
 Opens to aromas of strawberries, raspberries and red cherry candy with nuances of lilac, dried herbs and blood orange. The medium-bodied palate is silky and expressive, offering a great balance of herbs, fruits and spices with a gently chalky frame and long, uplifted finish.
- FAILLA \$66**
 157 2021 WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON
 Bright and aromatic with notes of pomegranates, orange zest, bright cherries, and dried herbs. This wine perfectly emphasizes the essence of the Willamette Valley.
- AMMUNITION \$58**
 162 2017, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
 Ripe black cherry framed by a subtle oakiness dominate the aromas of this medium-to-full bodied Pinot Noir. Earthy cherry and strawberry flavors with subtle oak tones of vanilla spice that are embraced by smooth, silky tannins.
- ALTA NAPA VALLEY \$95**
 163 2016, CARNEROS
 Expressive nose of black cherries, mulberries and black raspberries with touches of violets and cinnamon stick, plus a waft of underbrush. Medium to full-bodied, the ripe, vibrant cherry flavors fill the palate, framed by satiny tannins and a racy acid line, finishing long and tangy.
- HARTFORD COURT \$81**
 165 2019 RUSSIAN RIVER, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
 Aromas of black cherry, blueberry, black currant, allspice, and loam are followed by flavors of wild raspberries, dark berries, and a crushed rock minerality. The dense entry is followed by a sweet and juicy mouthfeel, supported by acidity, silky tannins, and a subtle earthy finish.
- BOEN \$68**
 166 2020 TRI COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
 Dark Plum in color with ruby red highlights. On the nose, luscious notes of raspberry swirl along side dark plum notes accompanied by hints of rosemary and sage. Rich and well balanced with bright blackberry, Bing cherry, dark chocolate and a hint of caramel on the palate.
- ANTHILL FARMS \$64**
 167 2020, SONOMA COAST, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA
 Pure scents of cranberries, blackberries, black tea leaves, fragrant earth and garrigue. In the mouth, it's concentrated but light on its feet with a silky texture, floral fruits, seamless freshness and a long finish.

- BELLE GLOS \$124**
168 2020, CLARK & TELEPHONE, SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA
Rich scarlet color, with aromas of brown spice, caramel and soft tea. The velvety palate offers flavors of bright red fruit, warm spices and sweet oak, supported by firm acidity and refined tannins.
- SEA SMOKE \$200**
170 2020 "SOUTHING" STA RITA HILLS, CALIFORNIA
The ever-changing nose of the Southing exhibits Montmorency cherry, sage, hibiscus and subtle baking spices. The fine tannins and minerality are enhanced by our estate vineyard's characteristic cool climate acidity.
- ALTO LIMAY \$45**
171 2018, PATAGONIA, ARGENTINA
Vibrant red in the glass with fresh floral aromas mingling with red currants, strawberries, and raspberries. A medium-bodied pinot noir with ultrafine tannins and a refreshing balance between fruit, mushroom, and mineral notes, with hints of spice and cocoa
- FROMM \$80**
172 2018, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZELAND
The cinnamon and clove spice get along graciously with the slinky red and blueberry fruit and floral characters. Tingly acidity on the palate makes the fruit pop. It's backed by savory, sappy notes and a talc-like cinch of tannins that hits just at the right spot.
- LOUIS LATOUR \$55**
191 2020 BOURGOGNE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Dark rubis color, is a fresh and elegant wine. It unveils red fruits aromas with roundness on the palate and silky tannins.
- DOMAINE EDMUND CORNU & FILS \$85**
194 2018, "LES BARRIGARDS" BOURGOGNE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Rich and softly textured, with an upright structure of dryness from a year in wood. The red fruits offer the potential for attractive liveliness in the future.
- ALAIN GRAS \$120**
197 2016, AUXEY-DURESSES TRES VIELLES VIGNES, COTE de BEAUNE, FRANCE
The nose reveals notes of blackberry, plum and small notes of cassis associated with small touches of black cherry, hints of red fruits, graphite / racy minerality as well as discreet hints of Zan, cardamom and spices. The mouth is juicy, slight and offers minerality, a beautiful / fine acidulous frame, dynamism as well as a racy minerality. On the palate this wine expresses notes of black cherry, black plum and small notes of fleshy cassis associated with small touches of fleshy raspberry, blueberry as well as very discreet hints of racy minerality, Tannins are fine and well-built.
- DOMAINE COMTESSE DE CHERISEY \$246**
198 2017, LA GENELOTTE BLAGNY PREMIER CRU, BURGUNDY, FRANCE
Blagny 1er Cru La Genelotte is a monopole vineyard, the only producer of this vineyard which is very rare in Burgundy. Showcasing the oldest vines of this property. Pinot Noir planted in 1934, this wine has enormous aging potential and will be an out of this world experience in years to come.

LIGHT BODIED REDS

- 200 **FEUDI DI SAN GREGORIO \$50**
 2017, AGLIANICO, CAMPANIA, ITALY
 Chewy and savory, this smooth young red doles out ripe black-cherry, juicy blackberry, licorice and baking-spice flavors. It's generous and ready to enjoy, with polished tannins.
- 201 **CUSUMANO \$38**
 2019, NERO D' AVOLA, SICILY, ITALY
 Lots of fruity, dark-cherry aromas and flavors with undertones of lemon peel and zest. It's medium-bodied with firm tannins and a lightly chewy texture at the finish.
- 203 **BODEGA GARZON \$42**
 2020, MARSELAN, URUGUAY
 Brooding nose with lots of blackberries, tar, hot stones and violets. There's a hint of dried black fruit, too. A full-bodied red, showing a solid mid-palate, laden with rich and supple blackberry fruit and silky tannins. Just very slightly potent on the nose.
- 204 **COMANDO G \$155**
 2020, "ROZAS", 1ER CRU, GARNACHA, MADRID, SPAIN
 It's tasty and long, has something herbal (fennel, celery), a salty touch, a little rust and a very mineral texture, with the grainy granite and finer chalk. It improves tremendously in the glass.
- 205 **BEN MARCO \$46**
 2019, MELBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA
 The freshness and saltiness to this is fantastic. Medium-to full-bodied, firm and super silky with an extremely long and driven finish. Vertical and focused.
- 206 **VAGLIO \$46**
 2018, TEMPLE, MELBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA
 Electric purple, with aromas of fresh plums, wild raspberries, lilacs, and sweet spice. Bold and forward, a sweet core of black cherry fruit ensconced in plush tannins. Chewy and ripe, but with a pleasantly lifted floral finish.
- 207 **PIATTELLI VINEYARDS \$50**
 2020, GRAND RESERVE, MALBEC, ARGENTINA
 An intense red color and aromas of black fruits, vanilla and smoke. These aromas are transformed to give the wine great structure and body on the palate. A soft fruit-forward flavor and a strong and balanced finish.
- 210 **DOMAINE DE LA MADONE \$45**
 2018, BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE
 Aromas of fresh raspberries, black cherries and violets, plus an intense mineral overtone. Le Perreon shares the noble character of the most refined French Burgundy, as the red fruit flavors puts on weight with some time in the glass, adding density, complexity, and freshness.
- 212 **TOUR DE PIERRES \$51**
 2019, ERMITAGE DU PIC SAINT LOUP
 The robe is crimson and purple in appearance. The nose is spicy (white pepper), mint, cocoa, red fruits. The mouth is full-bodied, balanced, with notes of pepper and licorice. The tannins are still tight, the length bodes well for the future.
- 214 **DOMAINE HAUVETTE \$115**
 2012 "AMETHYST ROUGE", LES BAUX DE PROVENCE, RHONE, FRANCE
 Vibrant and juicy - almost blackcurrant jammy. On the palate it is much drier, with dusty tannins and a silky texture. There is a finely-wrought fruit quality and good length. Balanced and very classy.
- 215 **BACKSBERG \$34**
 2018, PINOTAGE, SIMONSBURG, SOUTH AFRICA
 Ripe mulberry and sweet strawberry flavors are complimented by subtle undertones of dried herbs. This Pinotage has a juicy mouth-feel with supple, tannins.
- 218 **DOMAINE DU GRANGEON CHATUS \$54**
 2019, COTEAUX DE L'ARDECHE, FRANCE
 Ample, violet-laced blackberry fruits, scorched earth, tar, graphite and licorice to go with a medium-bodied, structured, yet elegant profile on the palate.

LIGHT BODIED REDS

- GARZON \$45**
220 2018 TANNAT RESERVE, MALDONADO, URUGUAY
A ripe blackberry aroma mixes with a touch of saline on the nose. The palate of this Tannat from a benchmark vintage is ripe and full in feel. Blackberry jam and spice flavors are ripe and satisfying, while this is warm and complete on the finish.
- ADA NADA \$60**
221 2019, "SERENA", LANGHE NEBBIOLO, PIEDMONT, ITALY
Marked by an orange-red tint to its color, the classic appearance of Nebbiolo, the wine is far from timid, showing a firm backbone of tannins that are a clear indicator of the traditional bent of this multi-generational domain.
- LUIGI \$63**
222 2018, PIRA NEBBIOLO PIEDMONT, ITALY
Ripeness with cherry skin, wild berry, pressed rose and some iron-rich soil. These results are simple and sharp, rendering an authentic and naked expression of the Nebbiolo grape.
- PRODUTTORI DEL BARBARESCO \$105**
224 2017, BARBARESCO DOCG, PIEDMONT, ITALY
